Aladdin requires no introduction to most of us. Based on the original fairy tale from *One Thousand and One Nights*, there are many versions of the same story. Our version is just one of them.

The plot centres around the wicked wizard Abanazar who has spent years searching for a magic lamp. Guided by the Genie of the Ring he learns that the lamp is hidden in an enchanted jewel filled cage in a land far away. However, there's a snag - only Aladdin, the washerwoman's son, who has fallen in love with Princess Jasmine, can enter. Disguising himself as Aladdin's long- lost uncle, Abanazar, spirits him away to a mountain cave to find the magic lamp. But all they find is a dirty old lamp that possesses extraordinary magical powers. How does it all end? That remains a secret for now.

The script comes from the English playwright Ben Crocker, a master of the genre. Crocker's scripts are known for incorporating all the quintessential pantomime elements: audience interaction, a villain and a hero, a princess, a pantomime dame and a cast of comic characters. Like all good pantomime, the script will include some contemporary satirical elements so that the story resonates on more than one comic level.

The production promises plenty of laughs, toe-tapping numbers and engaging comic roles,

PRINCESS JASMINE	Female – 20 – 30 ish	A modern girl with the ability to perform basic Kung Fu! Falls for Aladdin	An ability to sing and dance essential
WIDOW TWANKEY	Male - mature	The pantomime dame. She runs a laundry and is Aladdin's mother	An ability to sing and dance essential
WISHY-WASHY	Any gender	A worker in Widow Twankey's laundry	An ability to sing and move preferred
THE EMPEROR	Male - mature	Princess Jasmine's father. Not too bright	
SERGEANT PING	Any gender/age	Part of a comedy duo with PC Pong	Non-singing role
PC PONG	Any gender/age	Part of a comedy duo with Sergeant Ping	Non-singing role
NOBBY – a panda	Any gender/age	Nobby does not speak	
Genie of the Lamp	Any gender/age	Cameo role. Can also be part of the chorus	
Genie of the Ring	Any gender/age	Cameo role. Can also be part of the chorus	An ability to sing preferred
CHORUS	Any gender/age	A chorus of citizens, cave sprites, Palace Attendants, Guards etc	An ability to sing and move essential
