

Due to COVID restrictions, seating may again be limited, but we are hoping to release more seats when restrictions are eventually eased. Also due to the regulations now in place for cleaning, sanitising and providing single use items to our patrons, we have reluctantly decided to raise the price of all tickets by \$2. This will mean that the costs for attending a play will be: Adult—\$23, Concessions—\$20, Members—\$19 and Children—\$17.
